

How to Make a Magnetic Bookmark

Hello, Sisters! Here's how you can create your own magnetic bookmark:

Printing

Print your design for the bookmark.

For the first laminating option (using an iron) or machine, we recommend 120gsm double-sided photo paper.

For the second option (self-adhesive lamination), use 180gsm double-sided photo paper for the best results. You can find these on Amazon.

Laminating

If you have a laminator, use lamination pouches to laminate the printed sheet.

If you don't have a laminator, here are two alternatives:

Option 1: Using an Iron

Place your printed design (on 120gsm paper) between the two sheets of a lamination pouch.

Protect it by layering:

Place the lamination pouch on a firm, heat-resistant surface.

Cover it with a towel or fabric that can withstand heat.

Use an iron (set to medium heat) as if ironing clothes.

Check frequently to ensure the lamination adheres completely to the print.

The setup should look like this:

Rigid Surface > Fabric > Lamination Pouch with Print > Fabric > Iron.

Option 2: Using Self-Adhesive Lamination Sheets

Print on 180gsm double-sided photo paper for better durability.

Carefully stick the self-adhesive lamination sheet over the printed design.

Press out air bubbles for a smooth finish.

Assembling the Bookmark

Cut out the laminated design.

Fold the bookmark neatly in half.

Attach self-adhesive magnets to the back of each side.

For best results, use thin self-adhesive magnetic sheets (available in A4 size). You can cut the magnet to the size you want. Thinner magnets work better to avoid bulkiness while maintaining functionality.

And that's it! You now have a beautiful and functional magnetic bookmark.
